



Graduate Student Scholarship

Applications are now being accepted for the Entomological Society of Manitoba Graduate Student Scholarship. This award (in the amount of \$2000.00) is provided annually to assist students in their graduate programs and is presented at or soon after the annual meeting of the Entomological Society of Manitoba.

To be eligible, a student must be enrolled in a MSc. or PhD. program at the University of Manitoba, the University of Winnipeg or Brandon University. The student's primary research focus should be in the discipline of entomology. A student must also be registered as a graduate student for at least 12 months prior to October 1 of the year in which the scholarship is to be awarded. Preference will be given to students who have not previously been awarded this Scholarship. Students must exhibit superior scholastic ability, high research potential and excellent communication skills. Closing deadline for applications is October 1.

Applicants should submit the following:

- their Curriculum Vitae, which should include contact information, education (completed and in progress), awards and honours, related experience, publications, presentations, and other information that the applicant feels is relevant to their application;
- a summary of their research project (100 words or less);
- transcripts (undergraduate and graduate, "unofficial" transcripts are acceptable).

Applicants should also arrange to have two academic letters of reference submitted, of which one should be from their supervisor.
